After reviewing the nominations, the committee has selected **Officer Travis Hall** as this month's recipient.

Lieutenant Stephen Oreskovich wrote in his nomination of Officer Hall the following:

In the month of January, Officer Hall responded to over 160 incidents and conducted 26 self-initiated incidents. He made 1 felony and 5 misdemeanor arrests, and 10 traffic citations and 4 non-traffic citations. These numbers include traffic stops/incidents that resulted in 4 DUI arrests (including narcotics) and 1 wanted person. On Friday, January 18th, Officer Hall conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle for operating without headlights. During the course of the traffic stop/field investigation, the operator was found to be DUI and seven sealed packages of suspected marijuana were recovered from the vehicle (IN#19-02556).

Officer Hall has been with the department just shy of two years. While he is still relatively new, he is eager to learn, takes constructive criticism well, and when unsure of something he asks appropriate questions to get the correct answer(s). He comes to each shift well prepared and highly motivated with a positive attitude. Officer Hall is a dedicated officer who proactively patrols any assignment given to him. He should be commended for his efforts.
